* Until 130 PM PDT Wednesday

* Long duration of high temperatures will combine to increase snowmelt from the remaining deep high elevations snowpack. Flows along the West Walker are expected to increase daily reaching peak flows mid to late next week. These peak flows will occur in the early morning hours and are likely to match or exceed earlier peaks.

* Impacts include potential flooding of rural roads and recreation areas in the Walker River Canyon and continued flooding of agricultural areas and rural roads in Antelope Valley.

* Minor Flooding is also possible along the East Walker Road below Strosnider Ditch.

* Potential for unexpected impacts due to prolonged high flows may also occur.

 Central Lyon County in west central Nevada...
- * Until 315 PM PDT Monday
- * Recent cooler temperatures have resulted in reduced flows on the West Walker River but decreases in headwater flows have been offset somewhat by increased releases from Topaz Reservoir. These increased releases are intended to maintain available storage to help mitigate anticipated additional high flows due to warming temperatures late this week and through the weekend.
- * Flows will remain elevated on the mainstem Walker River through the Mason-Yerington area with minor flooding in low lying areas adjacent to the river. Farther downstream, minor flooding will continue in the vicinity of Wabuska down to Weber Reservoir.
- * Flows are expected to drop slowly until Thursday when they are expected to slowly climb again with renewed snowmelt. Any changes in current water management or anticipated weather will impact the river forecasts.
