#### **Job Duties:**

##### **General Expectations:**

- Be able to work under stress and heavy workload.
- Build and maintain positive working relationship with co-workers, other District employees and the public.
- Perform effective oral and written communication.
- Obey safe workplace practices, procedures, and regulations including wearing protective equipment and safety devices; maintain OSHA training.
- Display basic construction knowledge including, but not limited to, cement forming and work, equipment operation, etc.
- Possess general knowledge of reservoir, canal, and office and SCADA equipment.
- 24/7/365 Availability in the event of an emergency.
- Acknowledgement of working with hazardous materials at times.
- Maintain daily records of work performed, locations, and resources used.
- Other related projects and related duties as assigned.

##### **Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) Technician:**

- Possess the ability to learn water measurement, data analysis, record reporting, and troubleshooting capabilities.
- Maintain accurate and timely records pertaining to work performed.

##### **Data Entry Technician:**

- Possess the ability to learn daily water delivery records, oversee water record corrections, monthly and year end water usage statements and reports, allocation assignments, etc.
- Maintain accurate and daily records using Accounting Tool program.

##### **Equipment Operator:**

- Possess knowledge and ability to operate heavy and light construction equipment in support of the construction, installation, maintenance and repair of the District's drains, canals and reservoirs.
- Perform grading, excavation, and installation work with graders, backhoes, dump trucks, bulldozers, excavators, and related equipment.

- Identify and perform preventative maintenance and minor repairs on vehicles and equipment.
- Load and transport heavy equipment to and from jobsites while adhering to transit requirements.
- Identify equipment needs for assigned work.
- Identify potential hazards with underground and overhead utilities. Perform and update dig ticket requests.

- Knowledge of SCADA Software and equipment or the ability to be trained in all aspects of SCADA Software and equipment.
- Knowledge of water measurement or ability to be trained in all types of water measurement.
